PROPOSED VERBIAGE

ARTICLE II

MEMBERSHIP

SECTION A-Membership shall be open to all women residing within the boundaries of Sun City West and Corte Bella, Arizona, without discrimination.

CURRENT VERBIAGE

ARTICLE II

Section B- A member who has been in the club more than five (5) years will be eligible to be deemed "an Emeritus Member" should she move from Sun city West to another Arizona city. As an Emeritus Member, upon paying dues, she will have the same rights and responsibility as an Active Member, excluding officer ship in the organization.

PROPOSED VERBIAGE

ARTICLEII

Section B- A Member who has been in the Club more than five(5) years will be eligible to be deemed "an Emeritus Member" should she move from Sun City West or Corte Bella to another Arizona City. As an Emeritus Member, upon paying dues she will have the same rights and responsibility as an Active Member, excluding officership in the organization.

IF we hold the vote in March we can allow the Corte Bella ladies to join in April. I thank you for you patience and understanding. We need new members. If you vote against Corte Bella I can see no future for our club. We are down to so few members and we have to do something to bring new people in.
